



Maintenance & Cleaning Advice- Oil

Your floor has been professionally sanded and finished with specialist Osmo Polyx® Oil.

Domestic cleaning:

- ◆ We recommend that for day to day cleaning the use of a broom, Hoover or light damp mop is sufficient.
- ◆ If there is heavier soiling, we recommend the use of Osmo Wash and Care in water and a damp (not wet mop) is used.
- ◆ When using water on the floor please make sure it is dried thoroughly to avoid any liquid penetrating the joints.

General tips:

- ◆ Ensure that all spillages are wiped up immediately and never allow water, moisture spills or cleaning products to remain on the floor for any length of time.
- ◆ Place durable mats at all building entrance ways, in order to trap as much dirt, grit and moisture as possible before it is trodden into the floor.
- ◆ Affix felt protective pads to the bottom of all furniture (e.g. chair and table legs) so that they do not scrape the floor when they are moved.
- ◆ We advise that furniture is lifted rather than dragged to avoid scratches.
- ◆ Try to avoid walking on your floor in high heeled shoes – although oak is hard and durable it is still a natural product and thus can be damaged.

Ongoing care:

- ◆ To maintain your floor to a high standard, we advise that your floor is professionally re-oiled periodically. We would encourage you to contact us for guidance, we are happy to offer free no obligation advice.
